- Seaside Gateway Trail, "a park within a park", Bridgeport, CT - installation of trees in the park and a bench commemorating our involvement in this project

- Kids Club – established in 2020 to educate members children on the mission of the Fairfield Garden Club
- Planting 100 American Chestnut Trees on ten sites on Fairfield Public Land with continued maintenance over the past 10 years

- Planting thousands of daffodils at Mill Plain Green, Brookside and Roger Ludlow Parks
- Seasonal floral workshops with clients at Mozaic Senior Center
- Hosting educational herb and bee teas at Ogden House
- Maintaining beehives, harvesting and bottling native honey from our hives located at Oaklawn Cemetery and Arboretum
